90 years of experience, 535 specialists, scientists and researchers, 16 testing and calibration laboratories accredited in the Polish Centre for Accreditation, and the only in Europe experimental mine, is a potential, which enables to make the most ambitious research projects, giving at the same time the guarantee of their reliable and high efficiency in their deployment and commercialization.

The Institute continuously improves its structure and organization as well as adjusts the incurred research topics to the needs of the economy.
