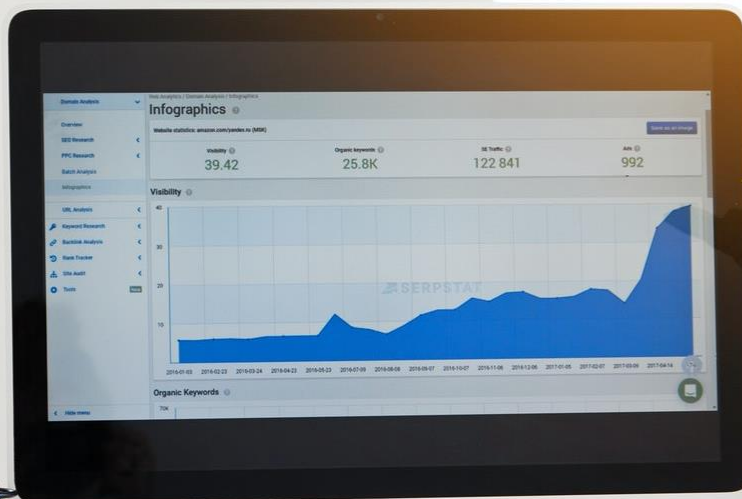

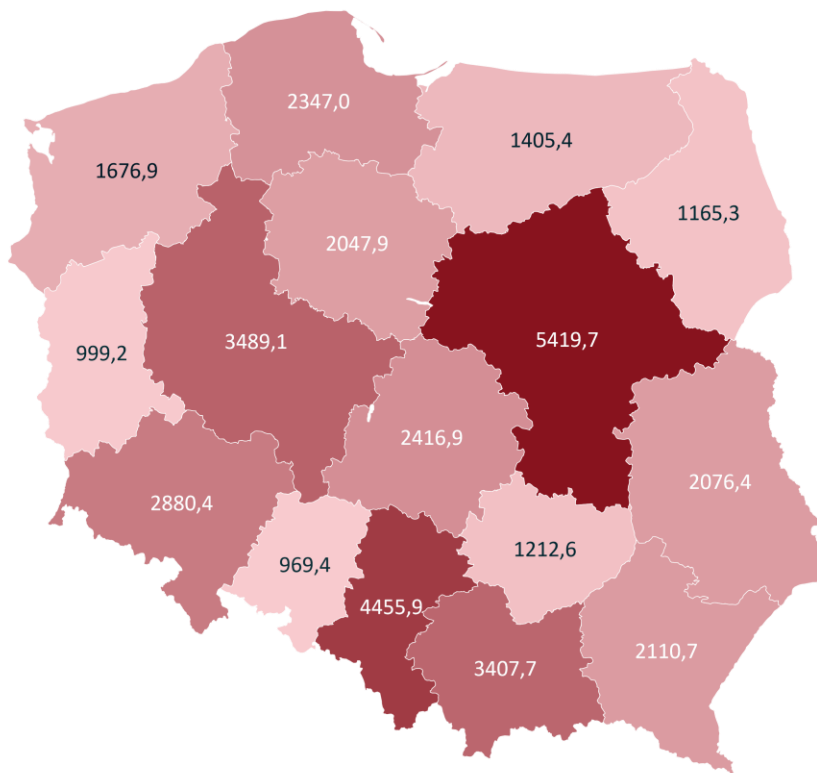

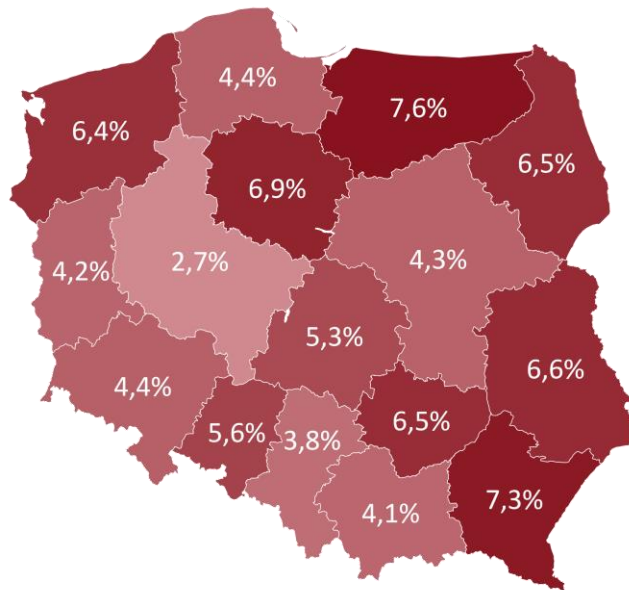


# The situation on Poland's labour market (1/2)

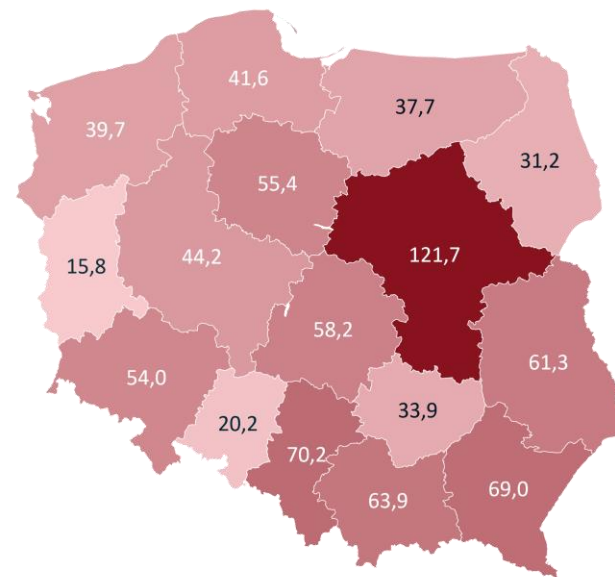
The registered unemployment rate at the end of June 2022 was 4.9%, which is approximately 0.2% lower than April 2022. In June 2021 the rate was 5.9%.

The number of registered unemployed at the end of June 2022 was 818.0 thous., compared to 850.2 thous. last month and 993.4 thous. in the same month last year.

Unemployment rate by region, June 2022, in %



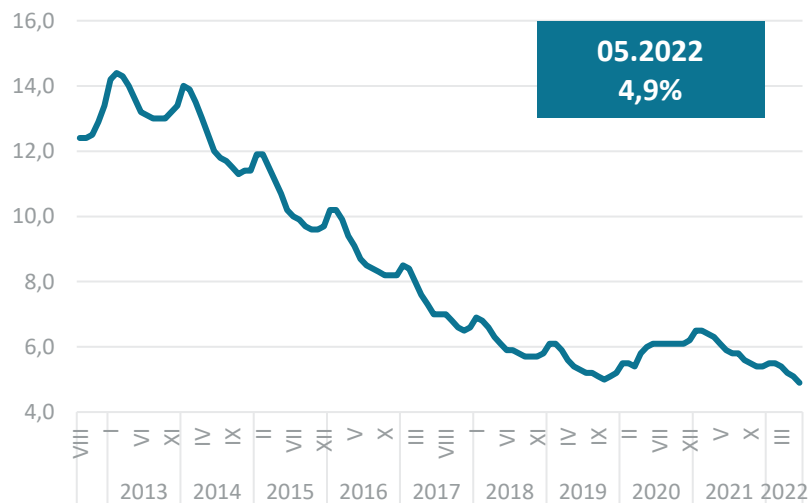
Registered unemployed by region, June 2022, in thous.



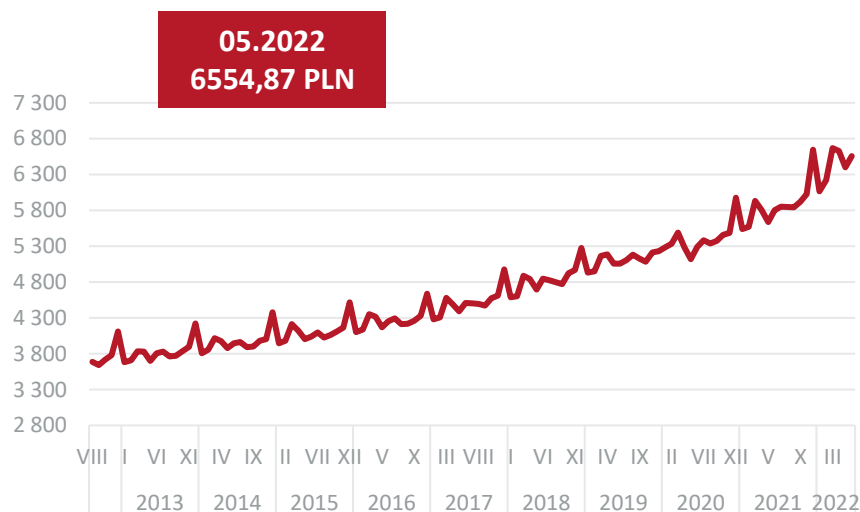
## The situation on Poland's labour market (2/2)

In June 2022, average paid employment in the enterprise sector compared to June 2021 was higher by 2.2% y/y and amounted to 6496.7 thousand full-time equivalents. In comparison to the previous month average paid employment increased minimally (by 0.1%). Average gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in June 2022 compared to June 2021 were higher by 13.0% y/y and amounted to 6554.87 PLN. In regard to May 2022 average gross wages and salaries increased by 2.4%.

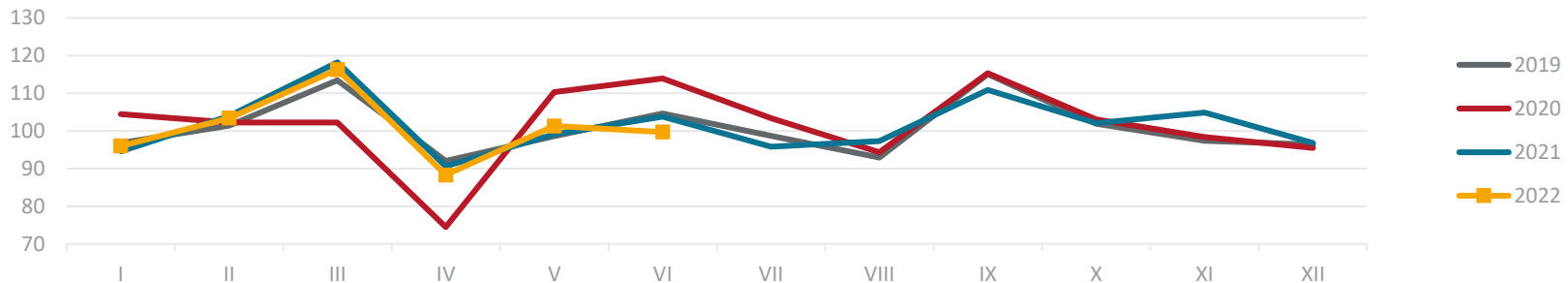

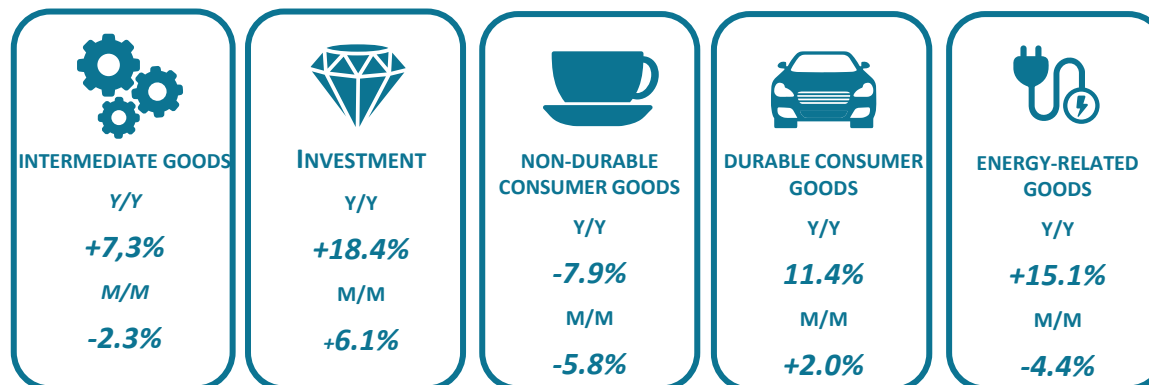
# Industrial production sales

In June 2022, sold production of industry was by 10.4% higher than in June 2021, when an increase was recorded by 18.1% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with May 2022, it decreased by 0.3%. In the period January-June of 2022, sold production of industry was by 13.6% higher than in the corresponding period of 2021, which saw an increase by 18.2%.

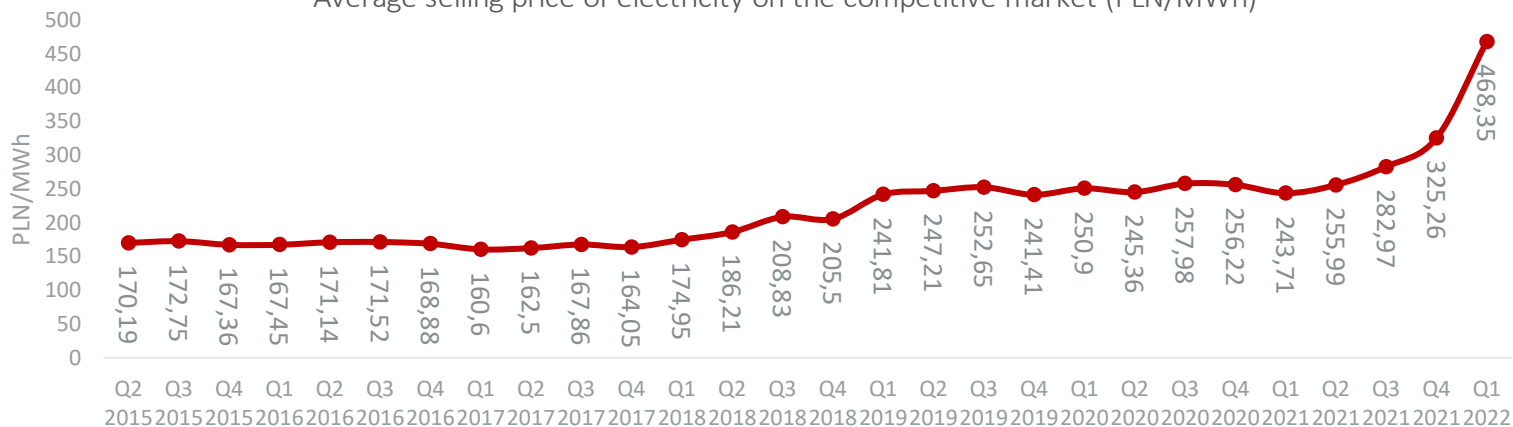

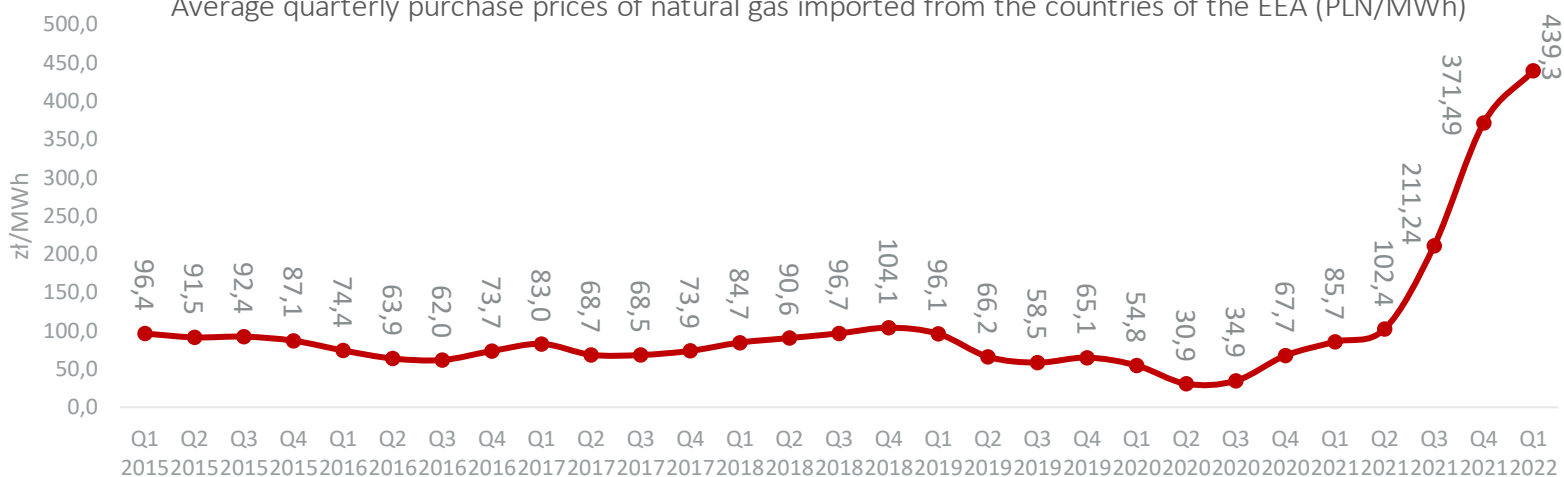

Average selling price of electricity on the competitive market (PLN/MWh)

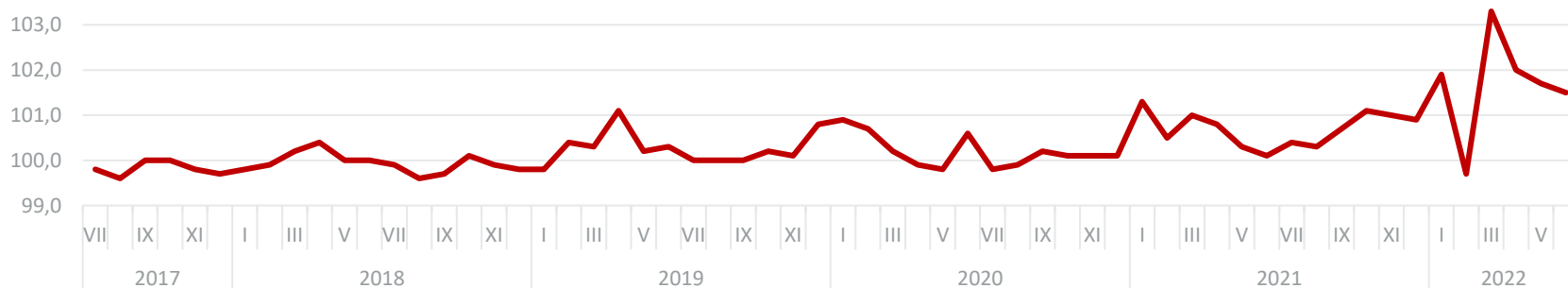


Average quarterly purchase prices of natural gas imported from the countries of the EEA (PLN/MWh)

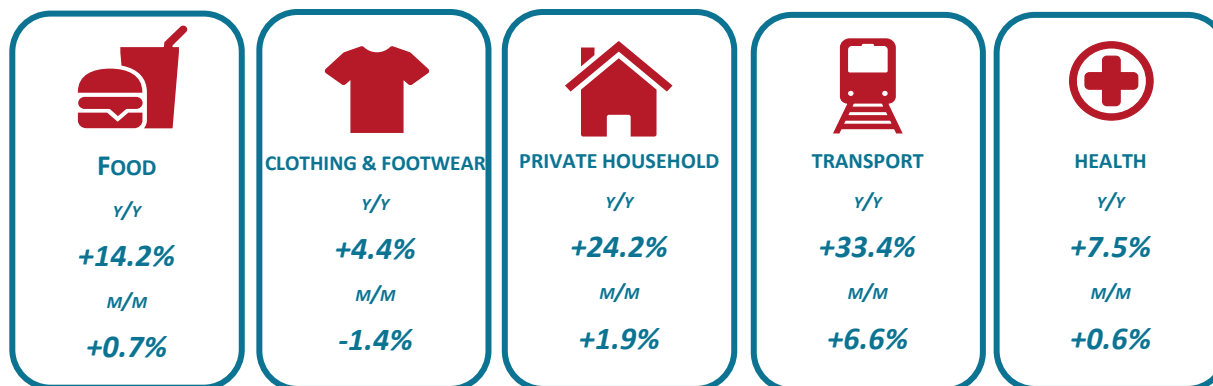


According to the data for June 2022, the value of industrial production prices increased by 1.6% compared to May 2022 and in comparison with that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year – by 25,6%. Consumer prices in June 2022 increased by 1.5% when compared to the previous month, while year-over-year prices increased by 15,5%.

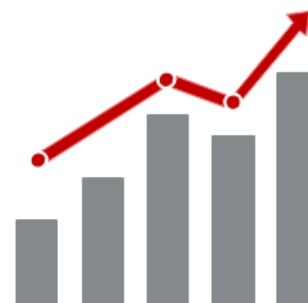

Foreign trade turnover in January - May 2022 in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 625.5 bn, while in imports - PLN 674.8 bn. The negative balance reached the level of PLN 49.3 bn, while in the same period of 2021 year was positive and amounted to PLN 16.8 bn. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2021 exports increased by 20.4%, while imports by 34.3%.

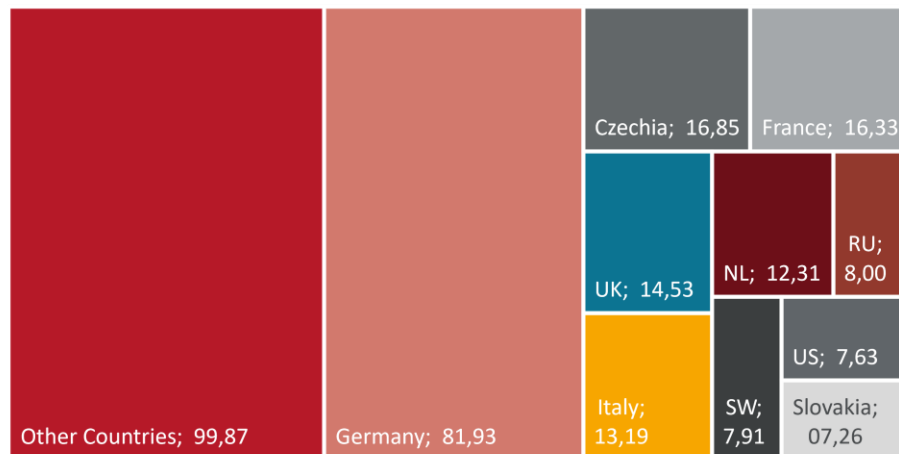

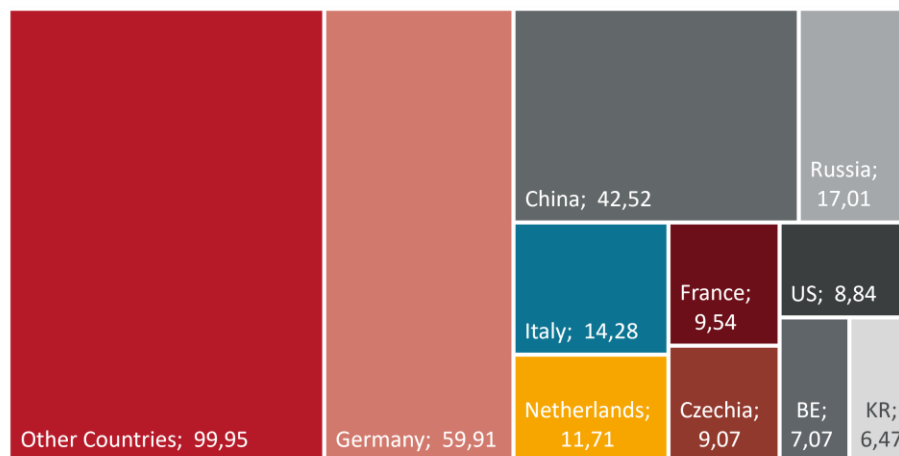

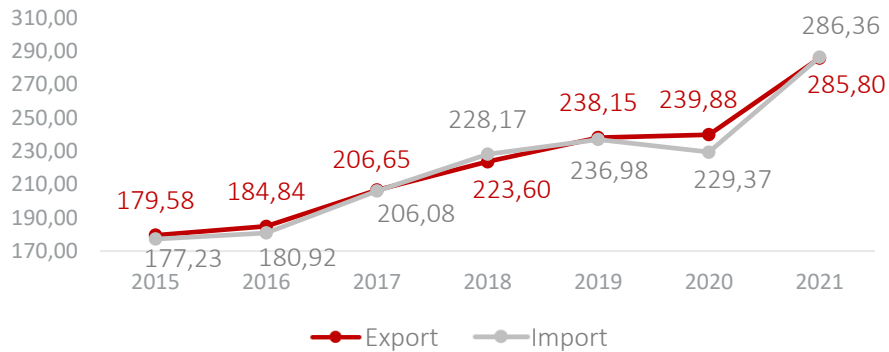

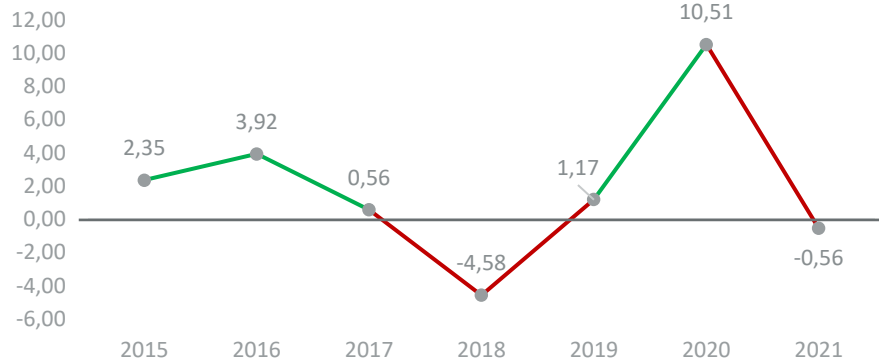

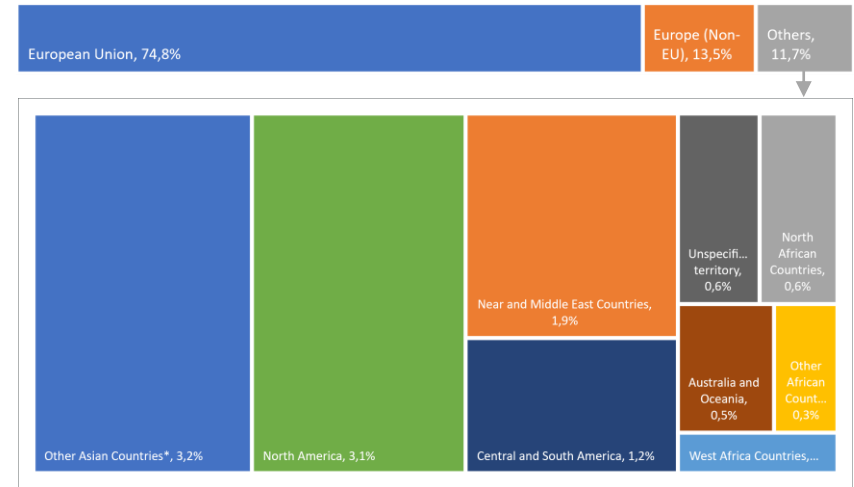
Trade turnover of goods (bn EUR)

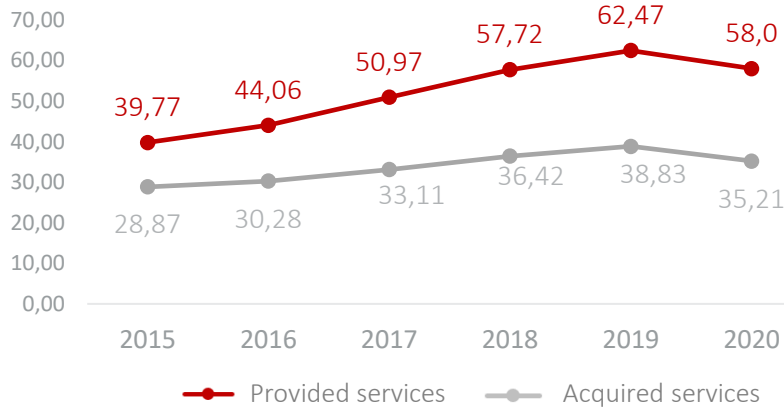

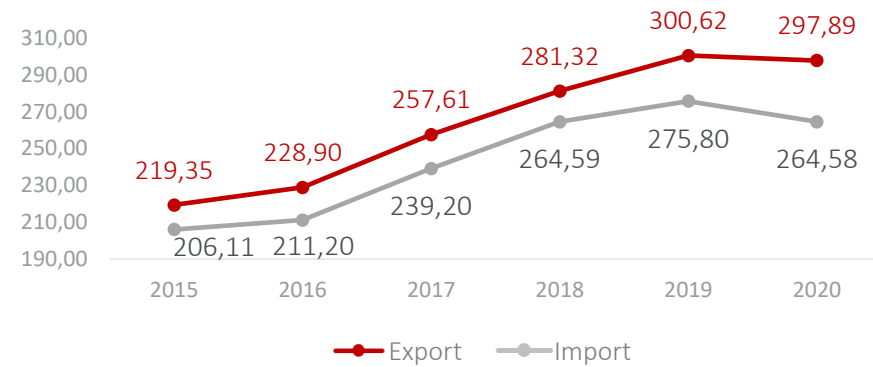
International Trade – services turnover (bn EUR)

Trade turnover of goods and services: TOTAL (bn EUR)

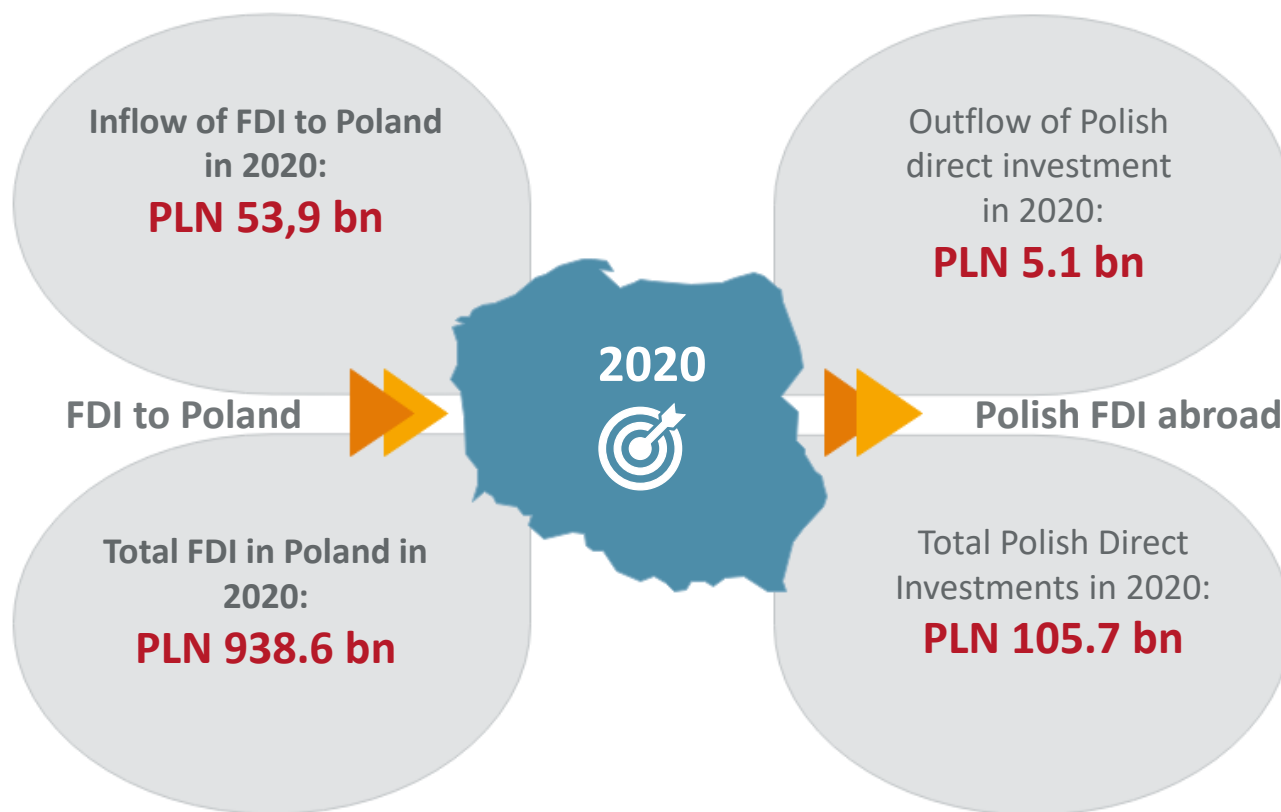


Trade balance of goods and services: TOTAL (bn EUR)



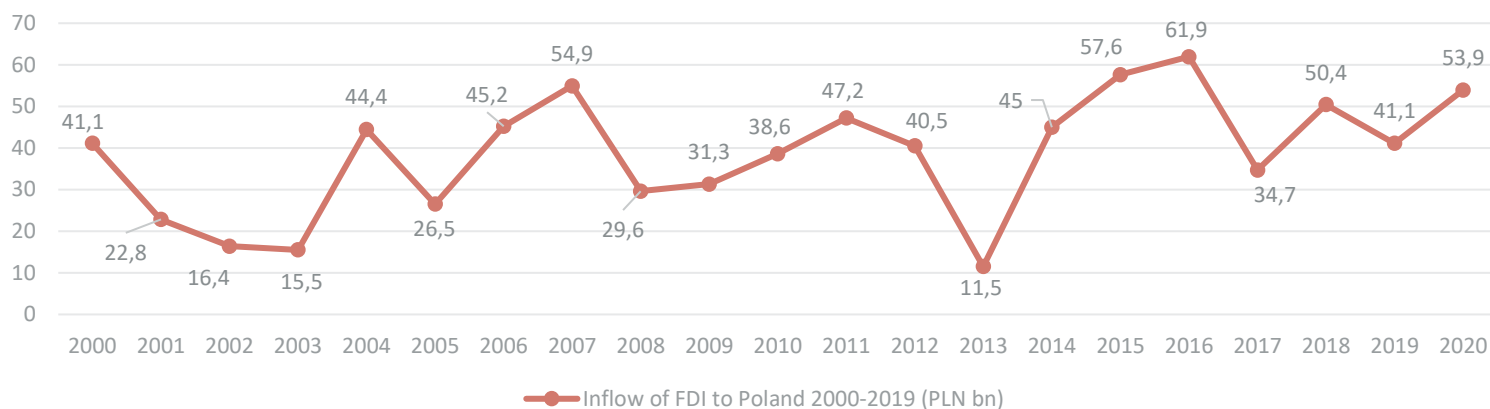
## Foreign direct investments (FDI) (1/3)

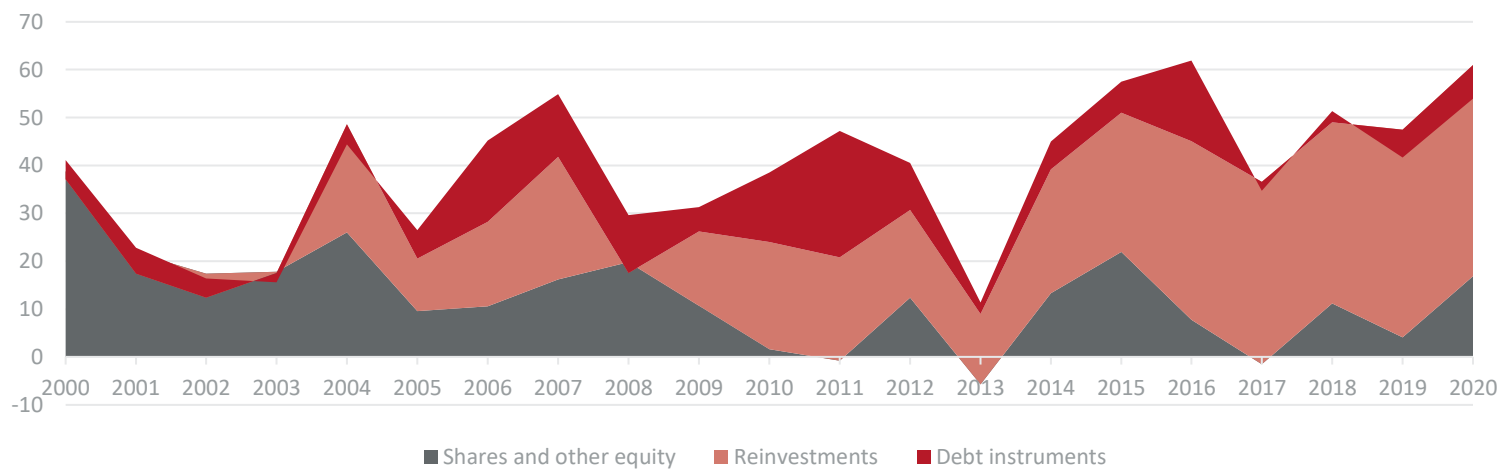

Inflow of FDI to Poland 2000-2020 (PLN bn)

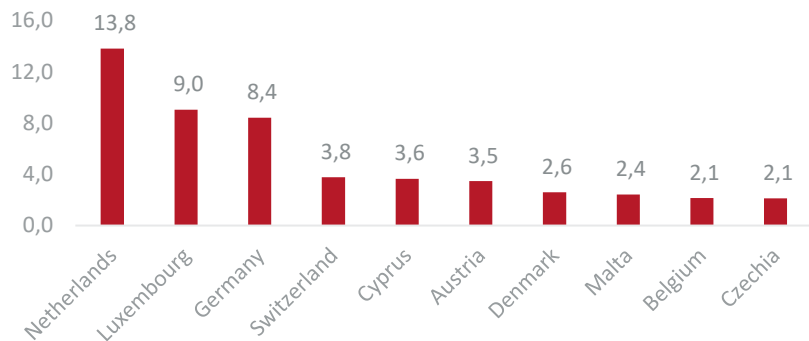


Inflow of FDI to Poland in PLN billion broken down by types of capital flows

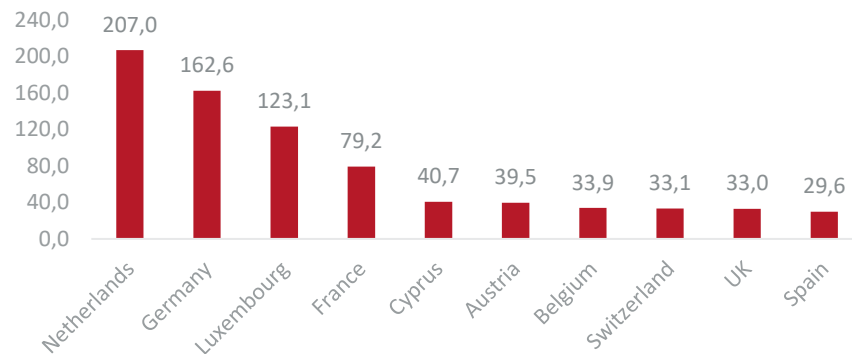

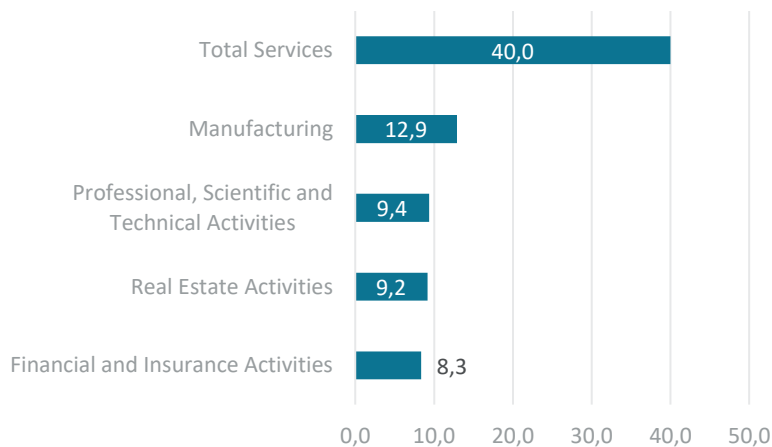
Inflow of FDI in 2020 by country of origin  
(PLN bn)



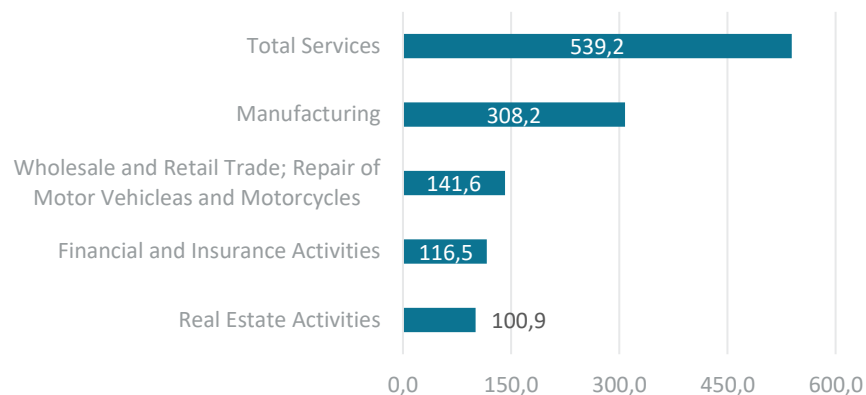
Status of liabilities due to FDI in 2020

FDI inflow in 2020 by sector (PLN bn)



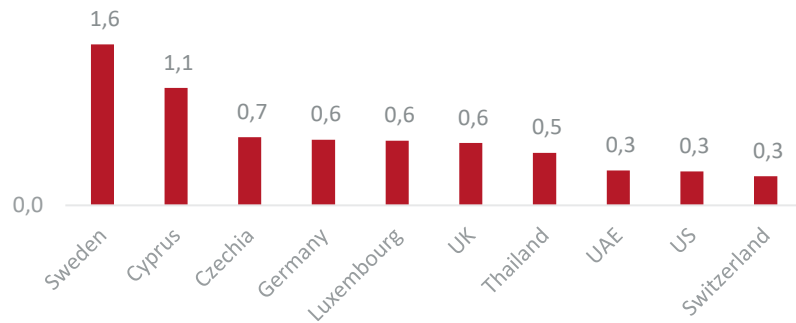
Balance on liabilities (Polish Direct Investments) in 2020:  
by sector (PLN bn)



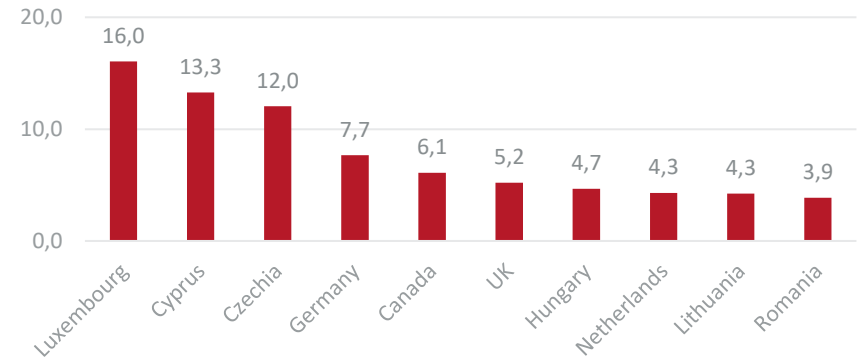

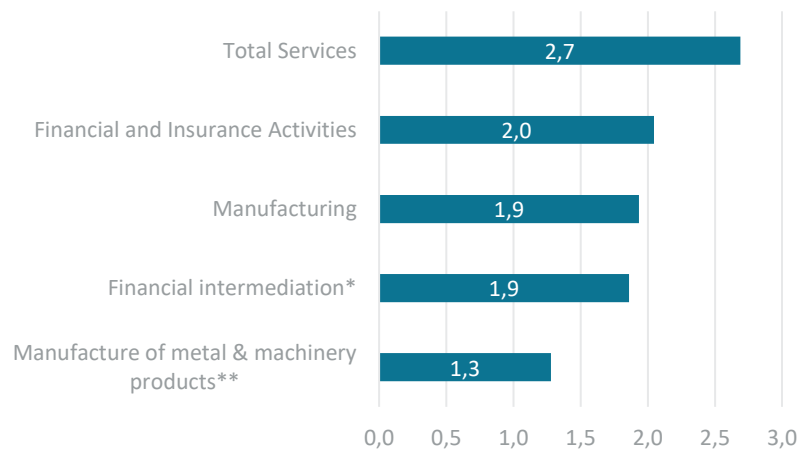
PIB outflow in 2020: countries of destination  
(PLN bn)



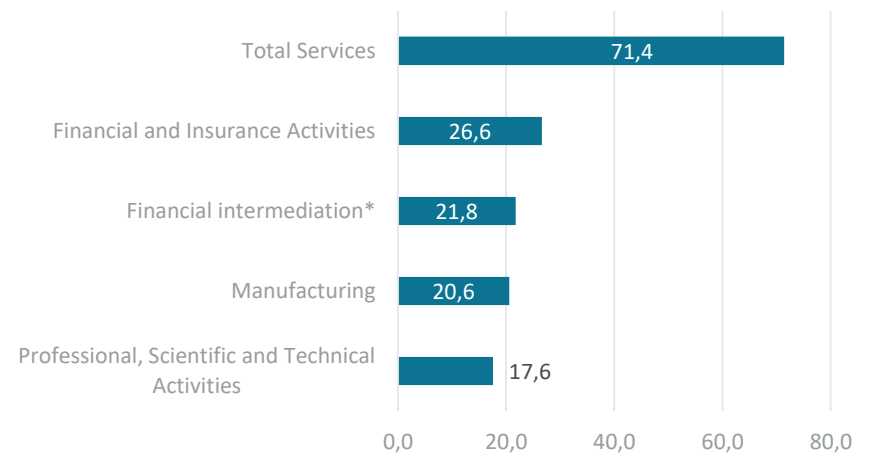
Balance on liabilities PIB in 2020: countries of destination

# National Bank of Poland – interest rates

*Basic NBP interest rates is a monetary policy tool that regulates the amount of money on the Polish market. By determining the interest rates, the NBP influences the level of the interbank market, and thus the interest rates on loans and deposits of Commercial Banks.*

*During its meeting on 07.07.2022, the Monetary Policy Council decided to **increase the interest rates.***

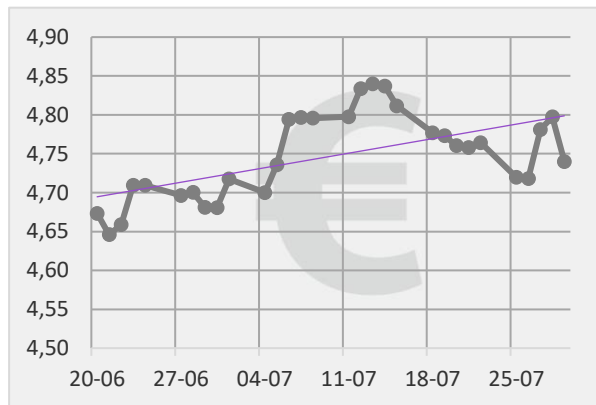

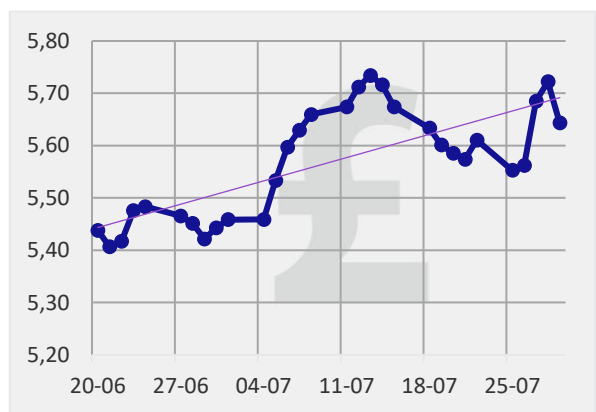
