

The population by region, July 2023 [thous.].












# The situation on Poland's labour market (1/2)

The registered unemployment rate at the end of November 2023 was 5.0% what was unchanged value comparing to October 2023. In November 2022 this rate was 5.1%.

The number of registered unemployed at the end of November 2023 was 773.4 thous., compared to 770.5 thous. last month and 800.2 thous. in the same month last year.



# The situation on Poland's labour market (2/2)

In November 2023, the average paid employment in the enterprise sector compared with November 2022 was lower by 0.2% and amounted to 6 494.0 thousand full-time equivalent employees. Compared to the previous month, the average paid employment was recorded at a similar level. The average monthly wage and salary in the enterprise sector in November 2023 compared with November 2022 increased nominally by 11.8% and amounted to PLN 7670.19 gross. Compared with October 2023, the average monthly gross wage and salary increased nominally by 1.7%.










# Industrial production sales




In November 2023, sold production of industry was by 0.7% lower than in November 2022, when an increase was recorded by 4.5% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with October 2023, it increased by 0.2%. In the period January-November of 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.4% lower than in the corresponding period of 2022, which saw an increase by 10.9% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021.

Industrial production sales in constant prices between 2019 – 2023 (previous month = 100%)








## Inflation




According to the data for November 2023, the value of industrial production prices decreased by 0.8% compared to October 2023, and in comparison with that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year – decreased by 4.7%. Consumer prices in November 2023 increased by 0.7%, while year-over-year prices increased by 6.6%.

Foreign trade turnover in January - October 2023 in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 1 349.8 bn, while in imports - PLN 1 301.2 bn. The positive balance reached the level of PLN 48.6 bn, while in the same period of 2022 year was negative and amounted to PLN 78.8 bn. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year exports increased by 1.2%, while imports decreased by 7.9%.



Collection of data on foreign trade turnover is open. Data published formerly is updated according to new customs documentation and INTRASTAT declarations. Final data will be available at the end of July 2024.









#### Trade turnover across years









# Foreign direct investments (2/3)







Inflow of FDI to Poland in PLN billion broken down by types of capital flows






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







FDI inflow in 2022 by sector (PLN bn)

Balance on liabilities (Polish Direct Investments) in 2022: by sector (PLN bn)









# PIB outlow in 2022: countries of destination (PLN bn)




#### PIB outflow 2022 sectors (PLN bn)

## National Bank of Poland – interest rates



Basic NBP interest rates is a monetary policy tool that regulates the amount of money on the Polish market. By determining the interest rates, the NBP influences the level of the interbank market, and thus the interest rates on loans and deposits of Commercial Banks.

During its meeting on 5-6.12.2023, the Monetary Policy Council decided to keep interest rates unchanged.






