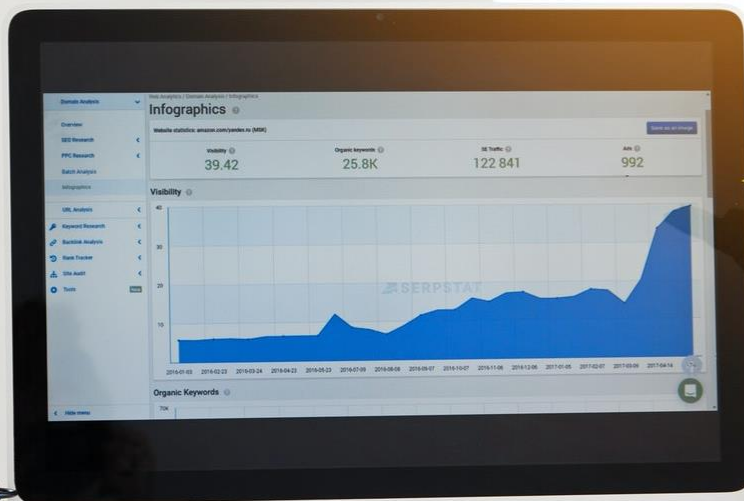

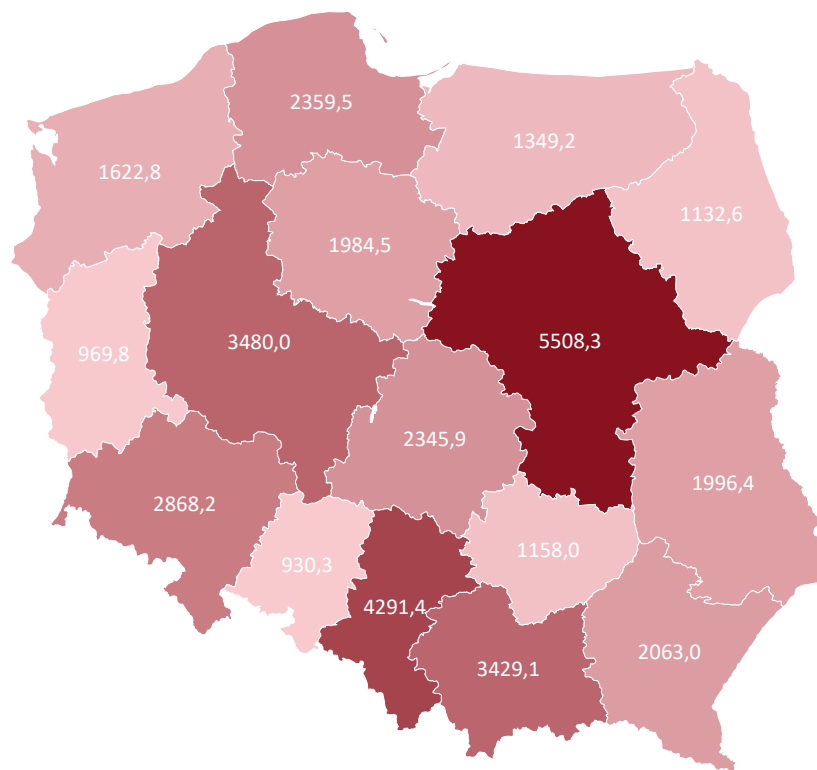

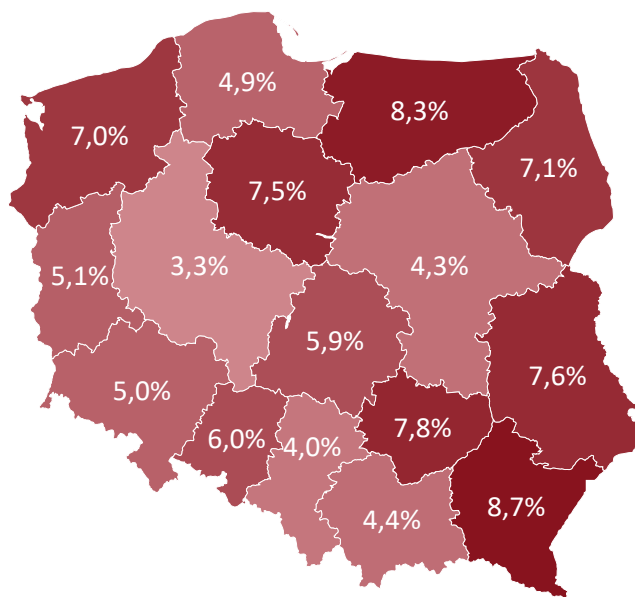

The situation on Poland's labour market (1/2)

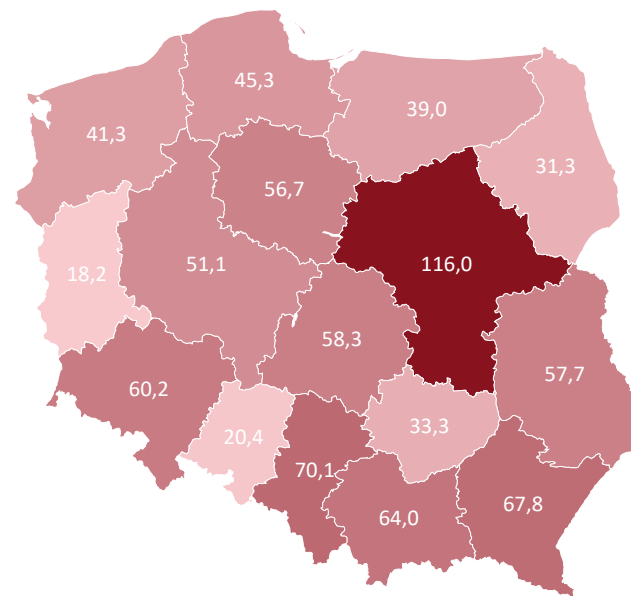
The registered unemployment rate at the end of July 2025 was 5.4%. Compared to the end of June 2025, the unemployment rate increased by 0.2 p.p., while compared to the July2024 it was 0.4 p.p. higher.

The number of registered unemployed at the end of May 2025 was 830.8 thous., compared to 797.0 thous. last month and 765.4 thous. in the same month last year.

The situation on Poland's labour market (2/2)

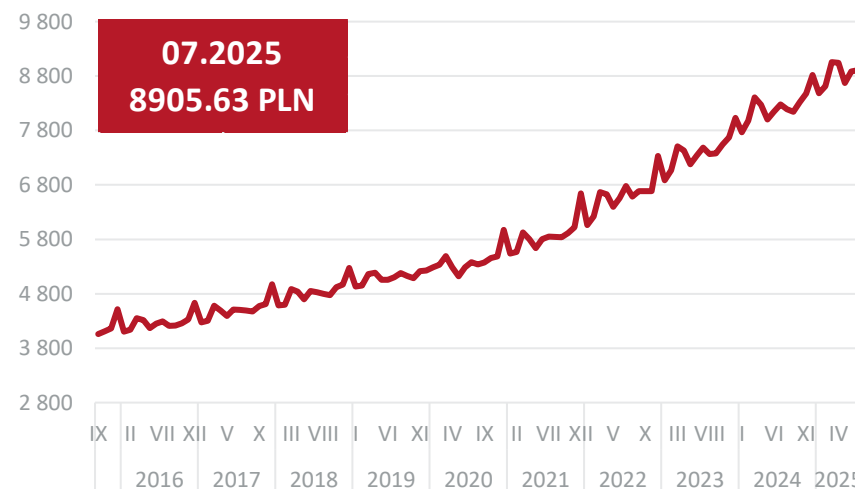
In July 2025, the average paid employment in the enterprise sector was 6 431.8 thousand full-time equivalents, 0.9% lower than a year earlier.

The average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector in July 2025 was PLN 8 905.63, i.e. it increased by 7.6% in nominal terms compared with July last year.

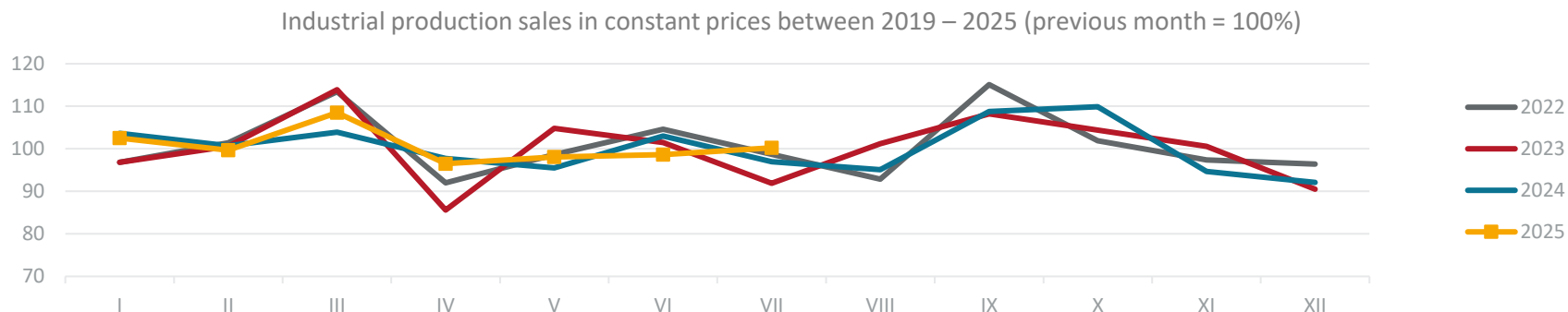

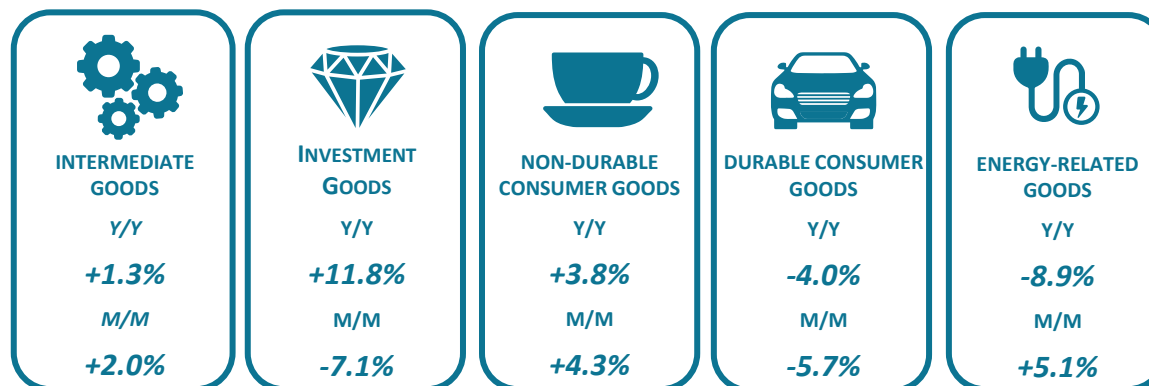
Sold production of industry

In June 2025, sold production of industry was by 0.1% lower than in June 2024, whereas in comparison with May 2025, it decreased by 1.1%. In the period January-June of 2025, sold production of industry was by 1.4% higher than in the corresponding period of 2024 (which saw an increase by 0.1%).

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in June 2025 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 0.1% than in the corresponding month of 2024 and by 0.5% lower than in May 2025.



Production of goods – July

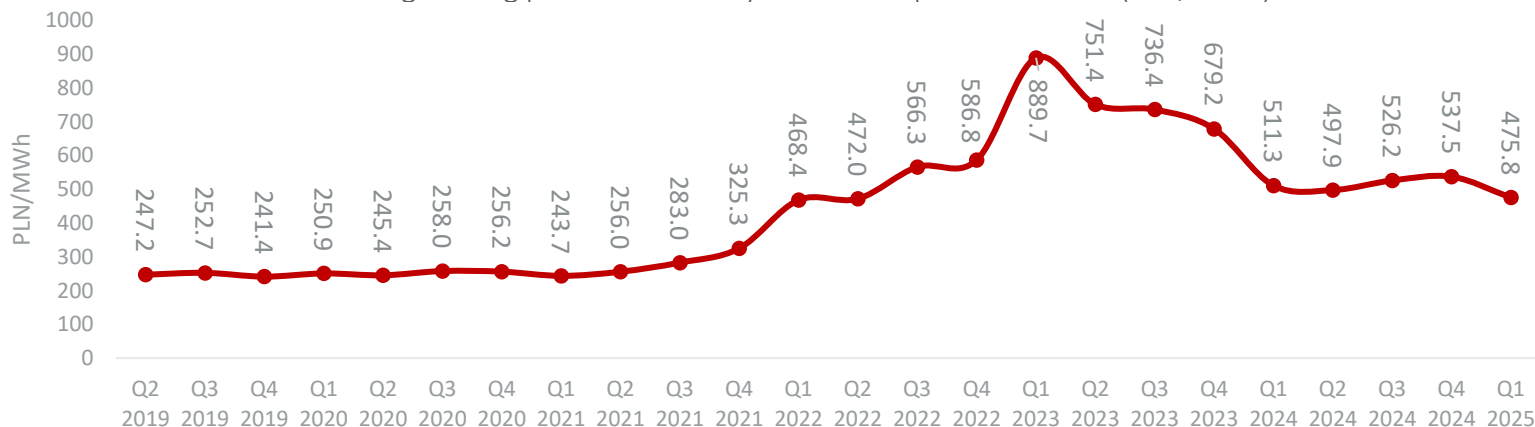


Electricity, gas and water prices

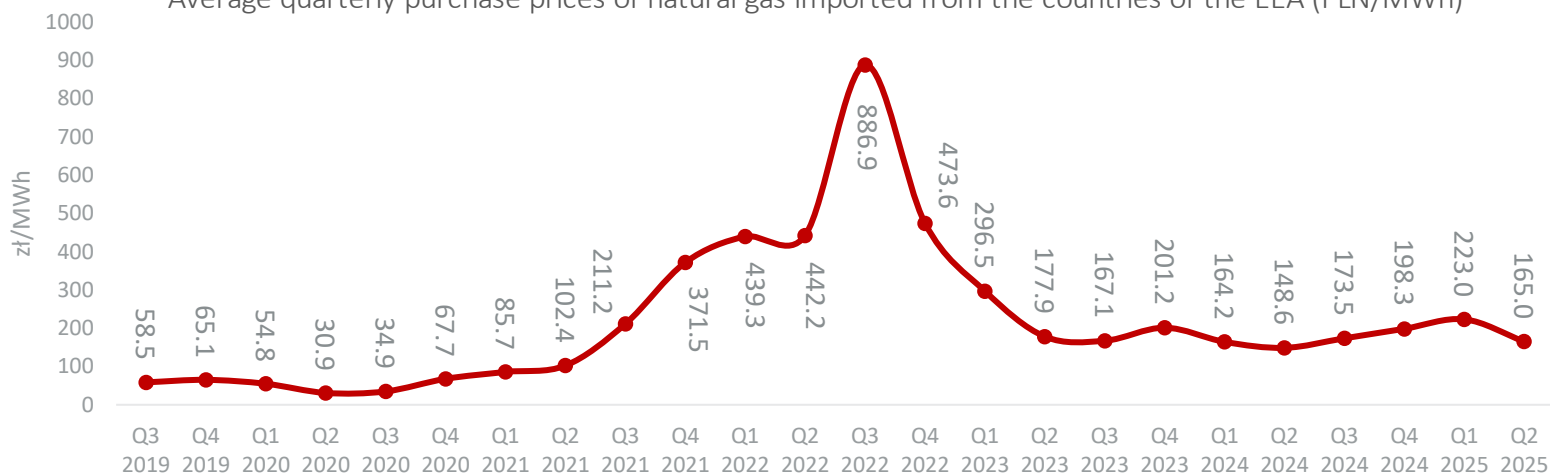


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Average selling price of electricity on the competitive market (PLN/MWh)



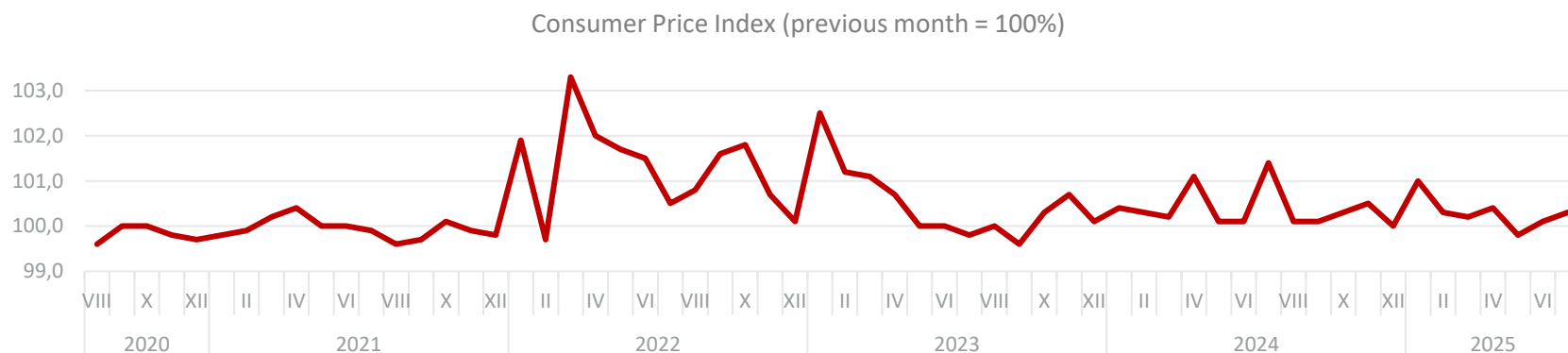
Average quarterly purchase prices of natural gas imported from the countries of the EEA (PLN/MWh)



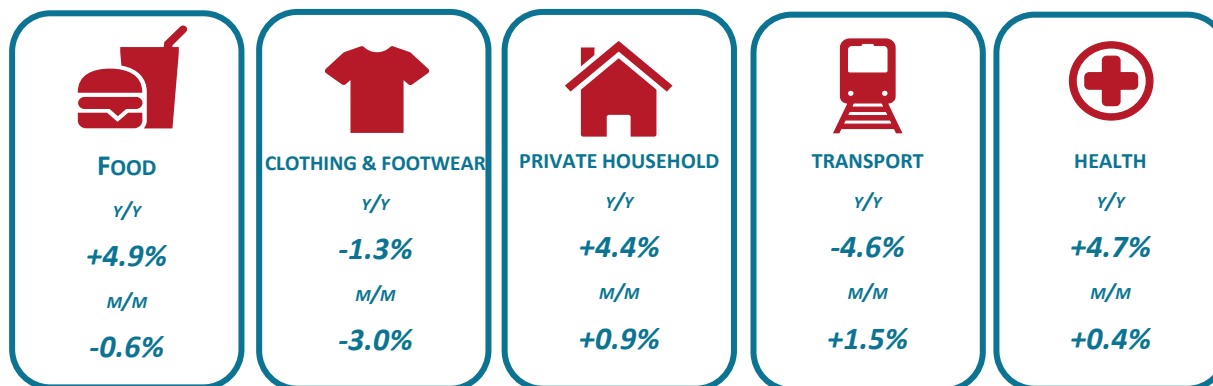

Inflation

According to the data, the prices of sold production of industry in VII 2025 has changed compared to a previous month by -0,1% and compared to the same month of the previous year by -1,2%. Consumer prices has changed by +0,3% compared with the previous period and by +3,1% compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.



Inflation – July



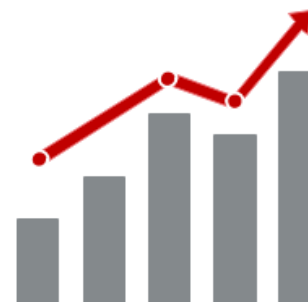

Foreign trade turnover in January–June 2025 in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 758.9 bn, while in imports - PLN 768.9 bn. The negative balance reached the level of PLN 10.0 bn. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year exports decreased by 0.6%, and imports increased by 3.1%.



Collection of data on foreign trade turnover is open. Data published formerly is updated according to new customs documentation and INTRASTAT declarations. Final data will be available at the end of July 2026.

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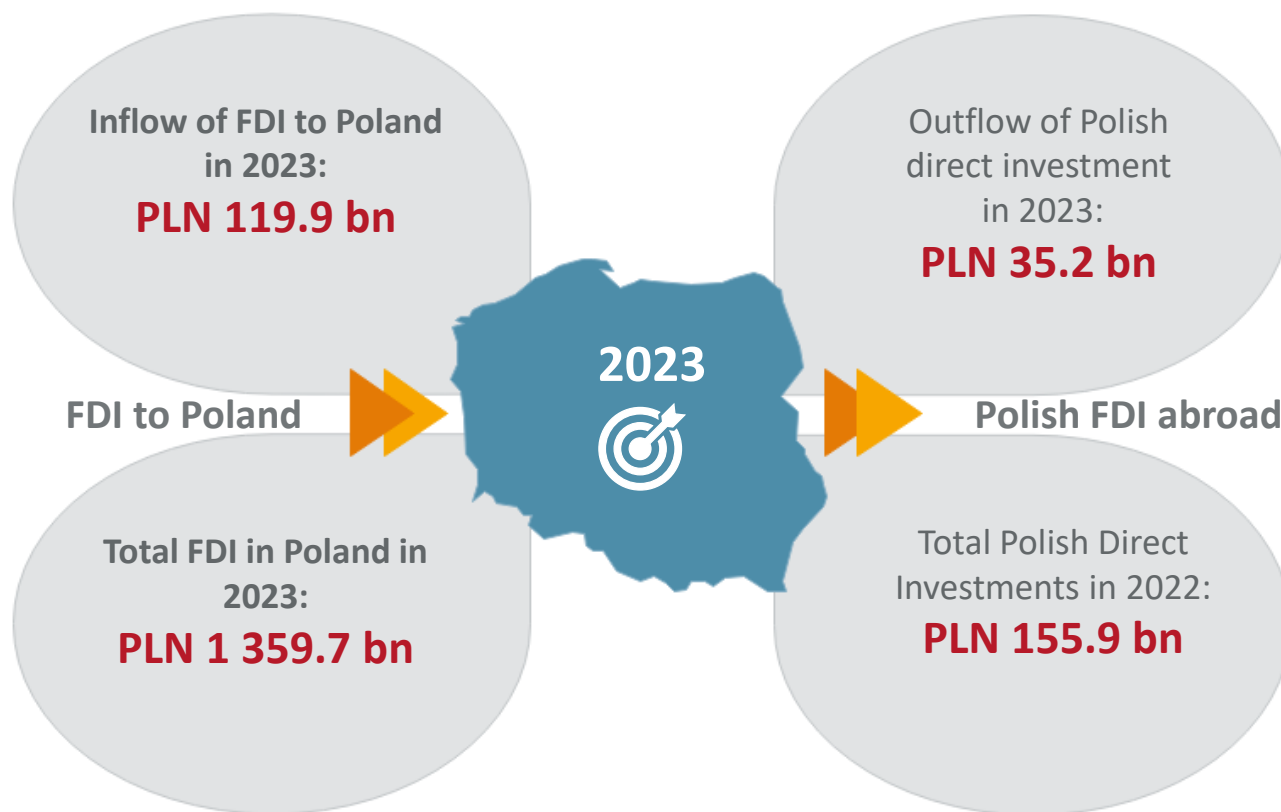

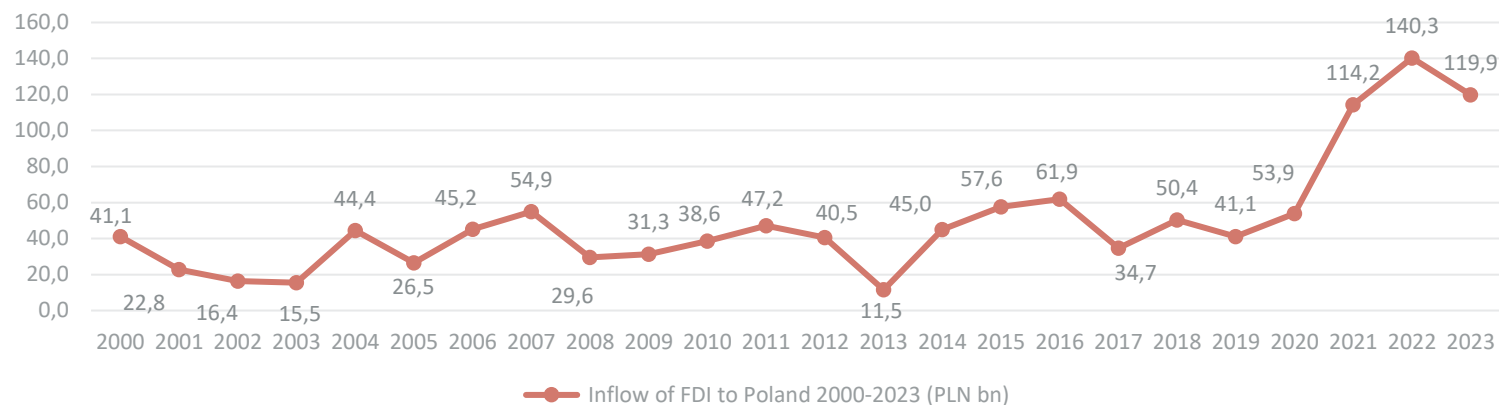
Foreign direct investments (FDI) (1/3)

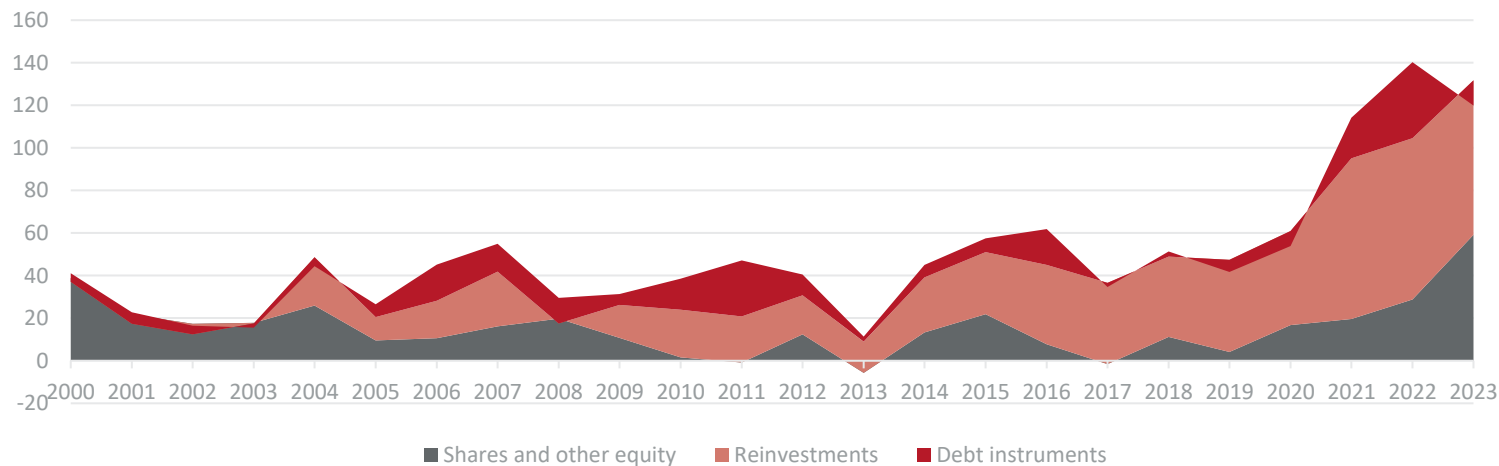


Foreign direct investments (2/3)

Inflow of FDI to Poland 2000-2023 (PLN bn)



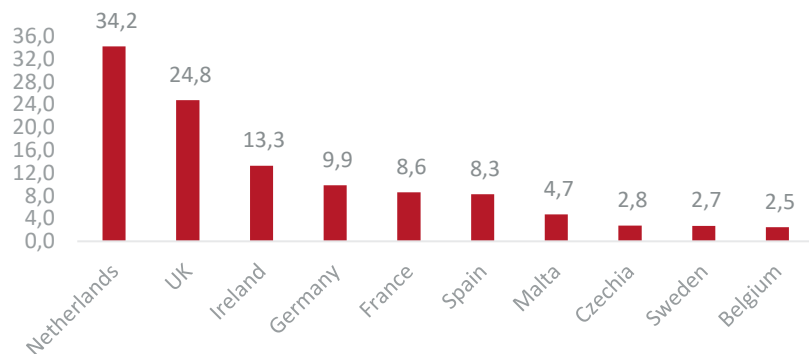
Inflow of FDI to Poland in PLN billion
broken down by types of capital flows



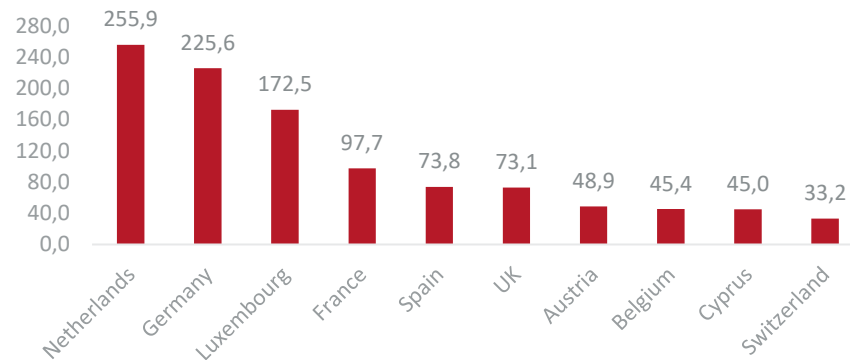

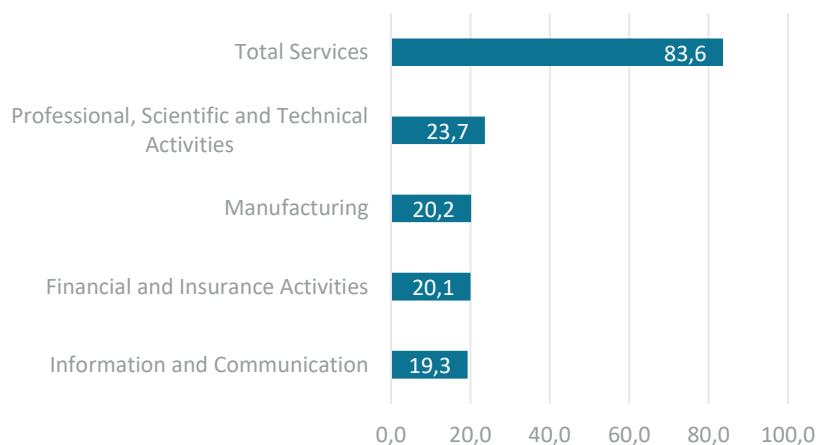
Inflow of FDI in 2023 by country of origin
(PLN bn)



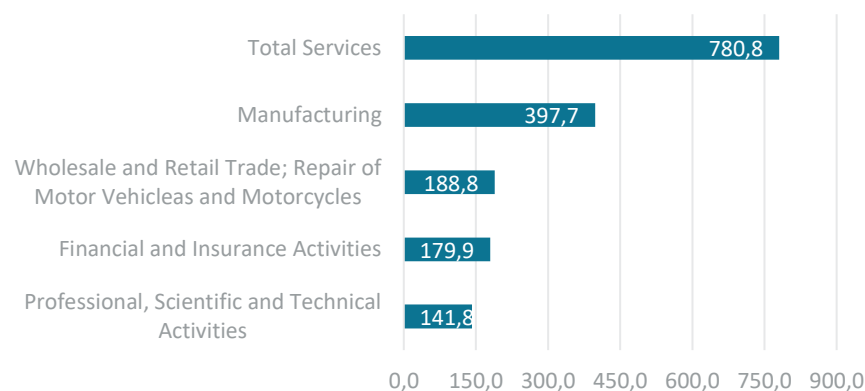
Status of liabilities due to FDI in 2023

FDI inflow in 2023 by sector (PLN bn)

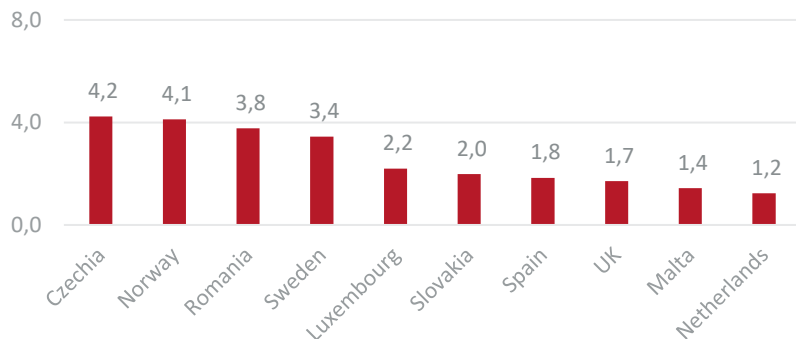


Balance on liabilities (Polish Direct Investments) in
2023: by sector (PLN bn)

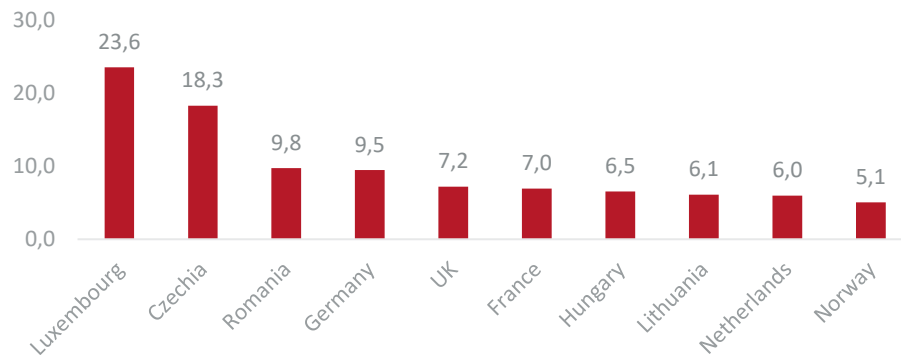


Polish direct investments (PIB)

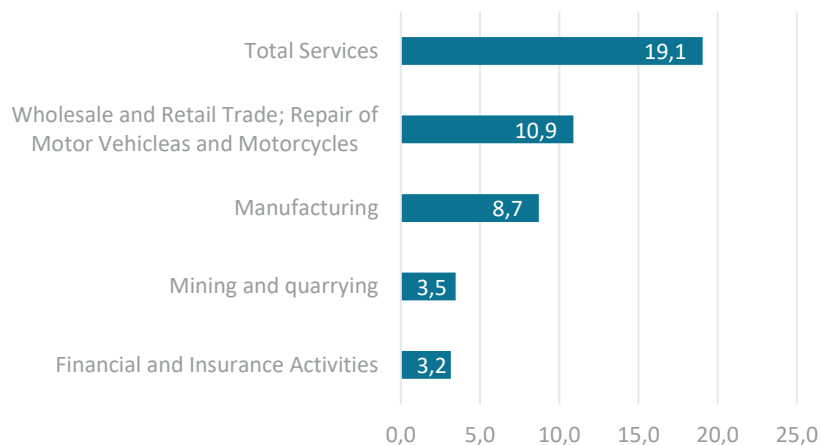
PIB outflow in 2023: countries of destination
(PLN bn)



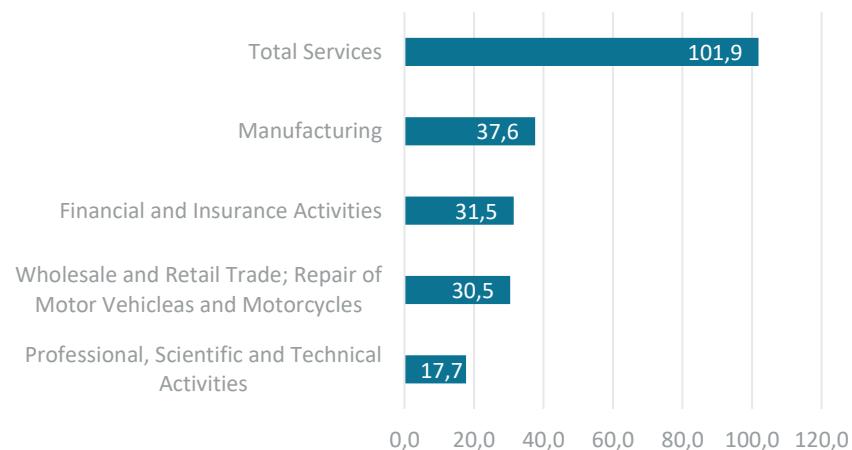
Balance on liabilities PIB in 2023: countries of destination

National Bank of Poland – interest rates



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Basic NBP interest rates is a monetary policy tool that regulates the amount of money on the Polish market. By determining the interest rates, the NBP influences the level of the interbank market, and thus the interest rates on loans and deposits of Commercial Banks.

During its meeting on 1-2.07.2025, the Monetary Policy Council decided to increase interest rates.



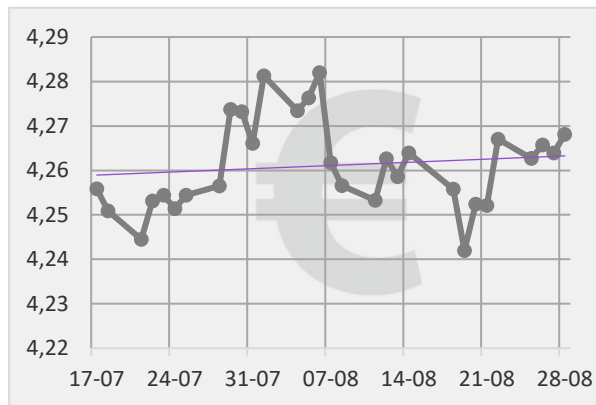

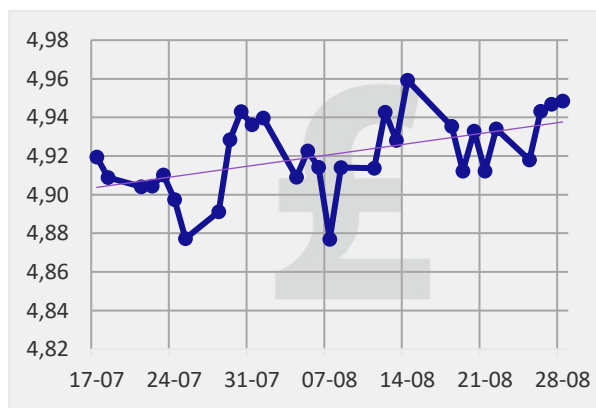

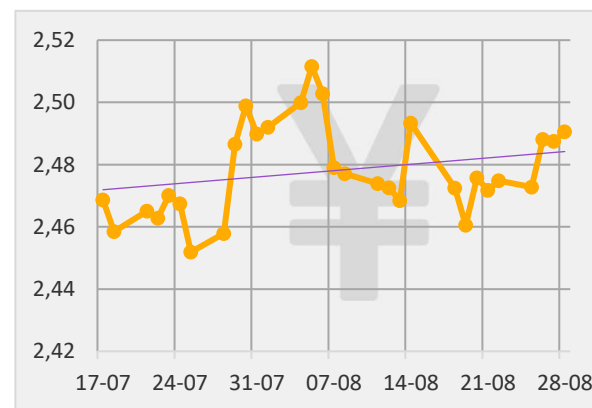
